Below, we have provided some key information about the survey.

Purpose of the Survey

The survey aims to:

- Give children and young people the opportunity to be heard and that their views influence decision making across Cornwall.
- The survey findings will help schools and colleges, Cornwall Council and other organisation to provide the right services and support for children and young people.
- This will help improve the health and wellbeing of children and young people in Cornwall.

Survey Details

- **Survey Topic:** Your child will be asked questions about themselves, their school lives, their home and community, their health and experiences.
- **Target Group:** Year 4 and up to Year 12 / Post 16.
- **Format:** Age-appropriate online survey, completed on a computer, tablet, or other device.
- **Duration:** Approximately 30 minutes for primary aged children and 50 minutes for secondary aged children
- **When:** March 2025

Confidentiality and Data Protection

- The survey is **anonymous**, and no personal identifying information will be collected.
- Data will be securely stored and used solely for the purpose of improving student outcomes.

How You Can Support

- Discuss the survey with your child and encourage their participation.
- Reassure them that their responses are anonymous and that their honest feedback is invaluable.
